Loss in Street Parking:

- 1. Driveways for new houses built in Grand Mere, removed hundreds of spaces along existing street curbs
- 2. Aggieville: 12th Street pedestrian amenities, Protected Bike Lane, and 14th Street reconstruction resulted in removal of street parking


